- Age is the biggest risk factor in developing breast cancer – about 75% of cases occur in women over 50.
- Early detection means a better chance of cure and less aggressive treatments. Women aged 50 to 69 can have a free BreastScreen mammogram by calling 13 20 50 from anywhere in Australia.
- Currently in Australia, over 130,000 women are alive with a previous diagnosis of breast
