

Supporting Women with Breast Cancer Today and Every Day

- Over 35 Australian women discover they have breast cancer every day.
- Approximately 1 in 9 women up to age 85 are diagnosed with breast cancer.
- Approximately 8 women in Australia die every day from breast cancer.
- 9 out of 10 women who get breast cancer do not have a family history of the disease.
- Age is the biggest risk factor in developing breast cancer – about 75% of cases occur in women over 50.
- Early detection means a better chance of cure and less aggressive treatments. Women aged 50 to 69 can have a free BreastScreen mammogram by calling 13 20 50 from anywhere in Australia.
- Currently in Australia, over 130,000 women are alive with a previous diagnosis of breast cancer.
